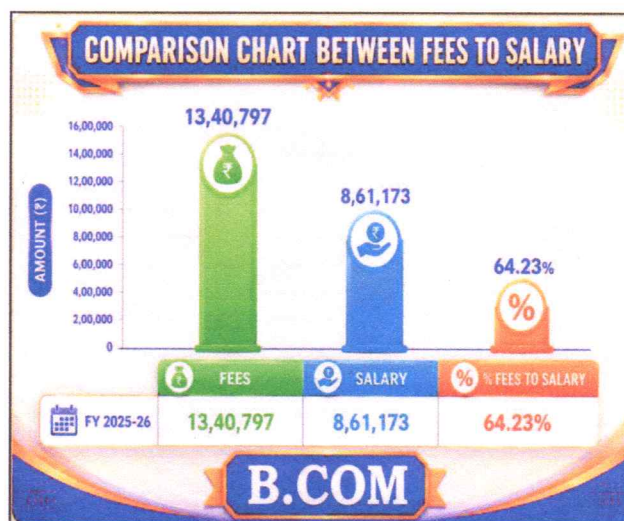
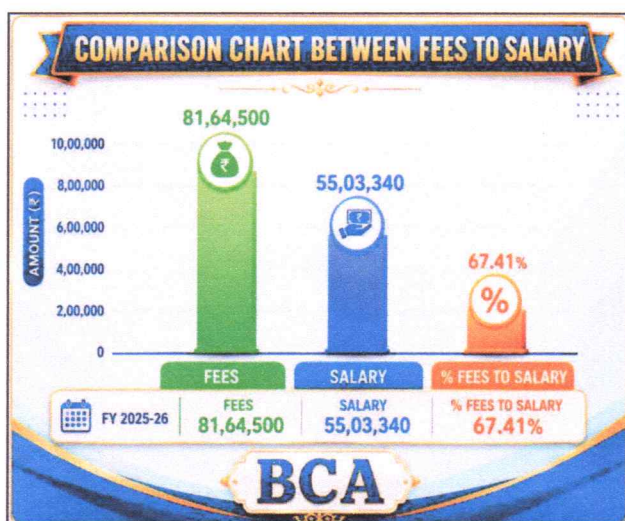

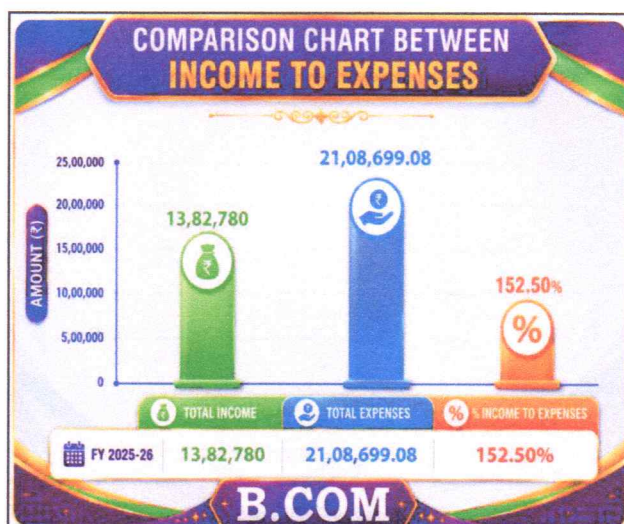
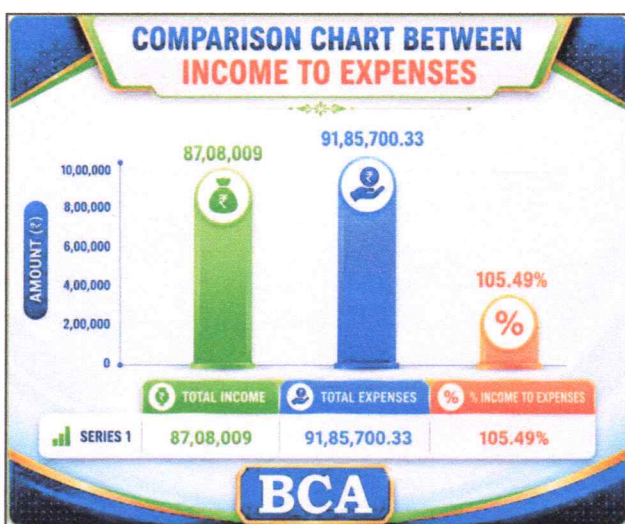

E) Student Activities:

- The Induction Programme for BCA and B.Com I Semester students was held from 30-07-2025 to 02-08-2025. The programme introduced students to the academic system, career opportunities, online learning platforms and campus facilities through interactive and motivational sessions.
- On 19-08-2025, "**LAKSHYA-2025**", a welcome programme for freshers, was celebrated with the inauguration of cultural and sports activities for the academic year. Shri Dattatreya Gaonkar, Principal of Vishwadarshan PU College, Yallapur, was the Chief Guest.

- In addition to Lakshya, the college observed and celebrated a wide range of important national and cultural events, including:
 - Independence Day and Republic Day
 - Teachers' Day and Women's Day
 - National Science Day and International Yoga Day
 - Matra Bhasha Diwas and Hindi Diwas
 - Constitution Day, Gandhi Jayanti, Valmiki Jayanti, and many more Each celebration witnessed enthusiastic participation from both staff and students, reflecting a spirit of unity, diversity, and cultural pride throughout the academic year.
- To provide students with ample opportunities to excel in co-curricular and extracurricular activities, a two-day fest, "**TECHNO SPARK-2025**," was organized in November 2025. The fest was transformed into an intercollegiate event. Shri Shivanand Kudlamat graced the occasion as the Chief Guest.
- Our B.Com students participated in the two-day Inter-College Fest "Eminence 2025" held at Bangur Nagar Degree College, Dandeli on 16th and 17th December 2025. Our college secured "**General Championship Trophy**".
- The college conducted its Annual Sports Meet, which added great enthusiasm to the academic year. Students actively participated in games such as Cricket, Football, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Lagori, and Volleyball.
- Our college boys' Kabaddi team participated in the Inter-Collegiate Kabaddi Tournament at Bhatkal and displayed commendable sportsmanship and teamwork.
- In the Inter-Collegiate Competition on "English Language and Literature" held at Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Education Society Arts, Science and Commerce College, Hubballi, our students achieved remarkable success:
 - Sadguni Tamse (BCA II Semester) secured First Prize in Elocution.
 - Pawan Jadav (B.Com II Semester) won Second Prize in Self-Composed Poem Recitation.
 - Tehmeena Shaikh (BCA IV Semester) and Seema Tigadi (BCA II Semester) secured First Prize in the Think Tank Quiz.

- Students also participated in the Debate Competition organized during Cooperative Week at Karnatak University, Dharwad, where Nagashree Vanakudri (BCA III Semester) Secured Third Prize. Students also actively participated in “ADVAIT” Management Fest organized at KLS Gogte Institute of Technology, Belgaum and in “UNIFEST 2025” organized by M.M. Arts and Science College, Sirsi showcasing their creativity, confidence, and team spirit.
- A major highlight of the year was the Five-Day Artificial Intelligence Training Workshop, organized from 29th December 2025 to 2nd January 2026 in association with ICT Academy under the CSR initiative of IBM. The workshop provided students with practical exposure to Artificial Intelligence, emerging technologies, hands-on training, and industry applications.
- A Three-Day Soft Skills and Interview Bootcamp was conducted from 12th to 14th February 2026 by Naandi Foundation, with the support of Mahindra Rise, Hyderabad. The training focused on communication skills, personality development, résumé preparation, interview techniques, and confidence building among students.
- The Fun Days were held from 4th to 6th April 2026, bringing fun, colour, and excitement to the campus. On the first day, a State-wise Food Thali Competition was organized, where students prepared a variety of delicious traditional dishes. Competitions such as Best Out of Waste, Face Painting, Nail Art, Folk Dance, Folk Singing, and State-wise Themed Presentations added cultural richness to the celebrations.
- The college also organized a motivational workshop on "Entrepreneurship as a Career" on 22nd August 2025, where Shri Sushil Mungekar inspired students to explore entrepreneurship, leadership, creativity, and innovation as promising career opportunities.
- To provide practical exposure beyond the classroom, students actively participated in HackFusion 2026, a 24-hour National-Level Hackathon held on 10th and 11th April 2026 at VBIT Engineering College. The event enhanced their teamwork, innovation, and problem-solving skills.
- An industrial visit for B.Com students was organized to VRL, Hubballi on 6th December 2025, providing students with practical exposure to industry operations and management practices.

- Students also visited LCC, Hubballi, as part of an industrial visit, where they gained valuable insights into IT industry practices, software development, career opportunities, and professional work culture.
- The Annual Gathering and Farewell Function for the academic year 2025–26 was held on 14th May 2026. Dr. N. Ramanjaneyalu was the Chief Guest.

Placements and Career Development:

- In association with Arctictern Solutions, a 14-week Internship Programme on Data Annotation for 2D & 3D and Quality Check for AI/ML Modules in Driverless Cars was conducted from 15th October 2025 to 31st January 2026.
- A total of 17 students participated in the internship, including 7 students from our college. The participants received stipends ranging from ₹5,000 to ₹7,000 during the internship period. Five students from our institution were successfully selected after the interview process.
- In association with Global Quest, a CSR Placement Drive was conducted for final-year BCA students in November 2025. The drive included aptitude tests and face-to-face interview rounds. We are pleased to announce that four students were selected for the CSR-based Training and Placement Programme.
- A Campus Recruitment Drive by Dhee Coding Lab, Bengaluru, was conducted on 24th February 2026. A total of 70 students participated in the recruitment process. Out of these, 25 students were shortlisted, and 9 students were selected for the Incubation Internship Programme.
- Another major achievement of the year was the Campus Placement Drive conducted by Randstad India Pvt. Ltd. for Tata Electronics System Solutions on 29th April 2026. A total of 98 students were placed through this drive, including 77 students from our college and 21 students from neighbouring colleges and alumni.

NSS ACTIVITIES:

- Our college successfully organized its first-ever NSS Special Camp for the academic year 2025–26 at Kesrolli Village from 27th November to 3rd December 2025. The camp was guided by NSS Staff Coordinator Shri Shantaram Chibbulkar. The camp helped students understand rural life and develop values such as teamwork, empathy, leadership, discipline, and service to society.
